Qualifications Information and Criteria

The Del Hubers Music Education Scholarship is awarded to eligible candidates who have chosen music education as their career. The scholarship is given in recognition of Mr. Hubers' **39** years of dedication to teaching music - mainly instrumental music. Over the course of his career, Mr. Hubers has taught general music, high school chorus, high school band, middle school band, middle school chorus and for the past **26** years - beginning band in the BV School District. Two candidates will be the recipients of a \$750 Scholarship Award chosen on behalf of Mr. Hubers.

Or one candidate will receive a \$1,500 scholarship - depending on eligibility of applicants.

An eligible candidate will have participated in BV Music during his/her high school career and completed the entire year. Special attention will be given to candidates who have participated in instrumental music all four years of their high school career. The eligible candidates will also be continuing their education at a post-secondary school in the fall following graduation and will be a music education major.
